This after Statistics SA's quarterly labour force survey for the third quarter showed that Limpopo's unemployment rate has gone up by 2.5% with 21 000 jobs lost in just a space of 3 months. PSA's Limpopo manager John Teffo says the statistics do not come as a surprise because of mismanagement of funds, but adds that the province's economy can be revived if serious consequence management is put in place.
