As an independent and politically non-aligned Union, the PSA will work with any democratically elected government, whether coalition or not. The magnitude of the challenges facing the country requires selfless and servant leadership. As in 1994, this moment calls for all, including civil society and trade unions, to recommit to the reconstruction and development of the country, to fostering unity and the recalibration of the economy.
