The Public Servants Association of South Africa (PSA) applauds the Premier of Mpumalanga and the MEC for Community Safety and Security for launching the *Nasi Ispani* project that aims to employ 1 200 crime-prevention wardens across 90 police stations in the province.

These wardens will collaborate closely with Community Policing Forums (CPF) and local law-enforcement agencies to establish a coordinated approach to crime prevention. Their responsibilities will include patrolling high-risk areas to enhance community safety and security.

This initiative is a significant step towards reducing crime whilst also creating job opportunities for 1 200 people in Mpumalanga. The PSA looks forward to more initiatives from the Office of the Premier that address the socio-economic challenges facing the people of Mpumalanga.
