The Public Servants Association (PSA) congratulates Mpumalanga for achieving an impressive 84.99% pass rate in the 2024 National Senior Certificate (NSC) examinations, a significant improvement from 77% in 2023.

This accomplishment reflects the dedication of learners, Educators, parents, and other stakeholders. Ehlanzeni District led with an 88.43% pass rate, followed by Gert Sibande at 87.67%, Nkangala at 84.24%, and Bohlabela at 78.6%. Hoërskool Nelspruit achieved a 100% pass rate, with 269 learners earning 366 distinctions, whilst Mkolishi Secondary School also maintained a perfect pass rate for the second consecutive year. Mpumalanga exceeded its Mathematics target with a 66.37% pass rate surpassing the provincial target of 60% and displaying the commitment to excelling in critical subjects.
