PSA mourns the loss of DRDAR shop steward



The PSA sadly learnt of the untimely passing of its shop steward, **Vuyolwethu Makhamba**, who was brutally murdered. His body was found with several gun wounds in the early hours of 6 March 2021.

Mr Makhamba who was an employee at DRDAR at the Botha Sigcau building in Mthatha, is believed to have been shot and dumped at the N2 between Mthatha to Tsolo. The PSA mourns the passing of its shop steward and extends condolences to the Makhamba family, friends, and colleagues.

Mr Makhamba's colleagues describe him as 'a cool guy, smart, handsome always with a smile, having a good human and gentleman character, always doing his work in a dignified manner and full of joy'.
