The PSA has learnt of the untimely and sudden demise of the Unions Shop Steward, Mr Thulani Petros Nyembe, who was an employee of the KwaZulu-Natal Department of Health stationed at Dundee Hospital.

The PSA is deeply saddened by the loss of one of its dedicated Shop Stewards who constantly fulfilled his duties without fail. Comrade Nyembe joined the PSA as a member on 30 November 2011 later becoming a Shop Steward and being re-elected in 2018 due to his diligent service to PSA members at Dundee Hospital. Comrade Nyembe was a loyal Shop Steward and member of the PSA who always prioritised members rights and interests at the Hospital. He worked hard to ensure that the grievances of our members were resolved speedily. He, together with his fellow Shop Stewards, also recruited a number of new members in the institution and as a result the PSA is the majority trade union, owing to their efforts of growing the Union of Choice in Dundee Hospital and surrounding clinics.
