Update: Payment of Union subscription

The PSA wishes to bring to the attention of employees who join the PSA that membership of the PSA is subject to membership fees of members being deducted from their salaries and received by the PSA. The PSA has observed that in some instances the PSA does not receive membership fees from employees who completed membership application forms. Such employees are not regarded as members of the PSA until their membership fees have been received. Unfortunately, when these employees experience problems in the workplaces that require Union representation, the Union is not able to assist as the membership verification process confirms them as non-members.

Other members are experiencing double deductions against their will as the cancelled union is receiving their subscription fees, despite the lapsed notice period. The PSA does not want members to be exposed without protection nor continue to pay double deductions.

Members are therefore urged to upon joining the PSA, ensure that the PSA membership fee reflects on their payslip. Those not regularly receiving payslips must check with their shop stewards or the employer.
