Feedback: COVID-19 vaccine rollout meeting

The PSA and other unions had a virtual meeting on 22 June 2021 to discuss the vaccine rollout plan for educators and support staff in the Limpopo Department of Education. The employer presented the plan as follows:

Contrary to what was previously reported that the vaccination will only be for educators who are on Persal, it will be extended to all educators and support staff including those appointed by SGBs. Educators must bring along an ID, salary advice and medical-aid card, although educators without medical aid will also be vaccinated. Schools must submit the support staff list to ensure that no one is omitted. The launch of the vaccine rollout will be on 25 June 2021 at Polokwane Provincial Hospital and union representatives will also be invited. Unions will be advised on the numbers per union to attend.

Those who are on leave will be vaccinated during a second round that will occur before 8 July 2021. However, they are also encouraged to attend the nearest vaccine centres whilst away from work. Districts, circuits and schools must establish committees that should include union representatives.
