

## Feedback: Uniform allowance task team - 13 September 2021

The lifespan of the task team was extended until 3 November 2021 to finalise outstanding items related to uniform of nurses. To date, the task team concluded the following recommendations for consideration by the Council:

- That the texture of the uniform should be min-matt fabric
- The colour of the uniform should be maroon and white, as there was a concern that blue and white is worn by many professions
- The colour of shoes should be brown, with brown belts
- The pattern of the male nurses' uniform should be chinos, with a line style and a straight cut

The task team was unable to conclude on the issue of the emblem for the nursing profession and parties were requested to submit proposals for consideration. The employer submitted a proposed emblem (*attached*).
