Update: Special Labour Forum

Performance assessments 2019/20

The PSA requested a special Labour Forum meeting following concerns from members over constant postponements by the employer to conduct performance assessments for the 2019/20 cycle. The employer cited institutional events, which include employees who are on leave, as the cause for delay to proceed with performance assessments. It was further reported that after a lengthy engagement with role players, the process will kickstart from 22 June 2022. All relevant stakeholders have confirmed their availability and the revised schedule will be circulated to all parties.

The PSA noted the report but registered its displeasure with the slow pace of the process and requested to receive a weekly progress report as a monitoring measure. The employer welcomed the proposal.
