- Proven ability to represent members at grievance meetings and disciplinary hearings.
- Nomination and election must be supported by Provincial Manager
- Must possess key skills and knowledge requirements.
- Have a valid driver's license and motor vehicle willing to use for PSA activities.

## **Strong recommendations**

- Flexibility in working hours. Must be able to work after normal working hours.
- Willing to learn.
- Willing to travel long distances and often sleep over in other towns.
- Must be able to work under pressure.

## **Key Performance Indicators**

- Assist members with grievance processes compiling grievances, conciliations, and arbitrations.
- · Advise, guide, or represent employees in disciplinary proceedings.

- Monitor employer's compliance with laws and collective agreements regulating terms and conditions of employment.
- Generate reports on employer's non-compliance with laws and collective agreements regulating terms and conditions of employment.
- Represent the PSA and participate in collective bargaining processes.
- Execute any other duties that may be assigned to him/her by the PSA.
- Recruitment and meet weekly target and retaining members.
- Arrange and attend meetings with members and stakeholders.
