Update: Mpumalanga GPSSBC meeting – 5 July 2024

The following issues were discussed:

GPSSBC Resolution 5/2014 (Agreement on recognition of improved qualifications in the Public Service)

Members will recall from previous communication that inputs from labour as per the qualifications set by the employer were already forwarded to the DPSA for configuration. Labour learnt with disappointment that the DPSA could not go ahead and approve the qualifications that had been submitted by respective departments because of minor errors. It had been reported that the DPSA had since returned the qualifications to the Office of the Premier for rectification. Labour expressed disappointment and the Office of the Premier committed to making a follow-up for correction with the respective departments by Monday, 8 July 2024.

Review of GPSSBC Resolution 1/2012: Governance Rules for Chambers – Council

It was reported that the Secretariat was still awaiting input from both employers and labour. Parties committed to submit these by 19 July 2024. Labour also requested from the Secretariat that training should be conducted should there be a need to amend the Collective Agreement.

The next Provincial Chamber will be held on 20 September 2024 and members are requested to submit new agenda items.
