Update: Stats SA dispute for organisational rights

Members have been kept informed of developments through previous editions of the *Informus* (copies can be obtained from the PSA's website at www.psa.co.za or from any PSA Provincial Office).

As members are aware, the PSA referred a dispute to the General Public Service Sectoral Bargaining Council (GPSSBC) regarding the interpretation of GPSSBC Resolution 3/2014. This action was taken after the employer (Stats SA) refused to recognise the number of shop stewards the PSA has across different provinces. The PSA also included the Department of Public Service and Administration in the referral as the custodian of the Resolution.

The PSA has now received a notice of set down for conciliation from the GPSSBC. The matter is scheduled to be heard by the GPSSBC Commissioner as follows:
