What is happening in Western Cape?

It has come to the PSA Western Cape's attention that some members have been "dropped" off Persal without them having resigned from the PSA. Some who have become aware have contacted their shop stewards or the office and completed new membership forms, to secure their membership. However, the PSA is aware that not everyone scrutinises their payslips every month and the PSA is concerned that some members may not be aware that their membership has been terminated by Persal. This may mean that members think they are still members of the PSA after the deductions have stopped. However, if they need representation, the PSA unfortunately will not be able to represent them if they are not showing as members on our membership system.

Members are encouraged to check their pay slips every month to ensure that the PSA deduction is reflecting. If not, and you have not cancelled your membership, members are urged to contact their shop steward or Organising and Marketing Officer (Brendon Jacobs, Liza Sampson, or Craig Appels) to ensure that membership is re-instated, even if it means completing a new membership form.

Members are urged to pay attention to the agency fee deduction that will reflect on member's payslip if a member is not a member of any recognised trade union. The agency fee is equal to the deduction of the union whose fees are the highest. This deduction does not provide members with representation if you should need it and members are encouraged to belong to the PSA, where you will have proper representation if needed.
