Border Management Authority (BMA): Oshoek Border

This serves to sensitise all Border Management Authority members stationed at Oshoek Border regarding ongoing picketing/industrial action initiated by a sister union of the PSA, which commenced on 10 March 2025. It is alleged that the picketing was in response to the incident earlier this year, where a truck collided with and severely damaged key border infrastructure.

Although this picketing action has not disrupted service delivery, members are sternly warned and reminded not to participate in any form of industrial action. The picketing is unprotected and does not meet the legal requirements for recognised industrial action under applicable legislation.

The PSA distances itself from this conduct and urges all members to continue with their official duties as normal. Members are further encouraged to report any issues or challenges of mutual interest to the PSA Provincial Office to ensure these are addressed through proper and lawful engagement processes, avoiding any irregularities. Members' cooperation and commitment to maintaining service delivery and adherence to lawful conduct are appreciated.
