Relocation of CPSI office

As members are aware, the Centre for Public Service Innovation (CPSI) office was temporarily accommodated at the Department of Public Service and Administration (DPSA). However, concerns were raised by members regarding the insufficient office space, which was too small to accommodate all employees adequately.

The PSA took decisive action, demanding that the employer should prioritise the health and safety of employees in line with occupational health and safety (OHS) standards. In response, the employer confirmed that a new building has been identified and that a quotation has been submitted to the Department of Public Works and Infrastructure for approval. To ensure that the new office meets required safety and working conditions, the PSA insisted on conducting an *in-loco* inspection, which will include the Department of Employment and Labour. The PSA maintains that if the new office does not comply with OHS regulations, it will not support the relocation of employees to the building. The employer has agreed to this demand, and the inspection is scheduled to take place on or before 28 February 2025.

The PSA will continue to closely monitor the process and will update members. Members' safety and well-being remain the PSA's top priority.
