## Update: Rotation of the EC Intersectoral Members Meetings!

The Gqeberha office has been receiving enquiries from members about the rotation of our annual Intersectoral members meetings, and with that we would like to clarify the matter as follows:

The *Statute* of the PSA (Section 31 (5)) dictates the following: *“In addition to the three branch or committee management meetings one inter-sectoral members meeting may be held with members during a financial year which can be rotated in the main centres, and which should be arranged by the relevant Provincial Managers. The costs to hold such an inter-sectoral member` meeting will be borne by the PSA.”*

Historically in the Eastern cape the annual intersectoral members meetings were rotated successfully according to the statute at the following main centres:

- Graff Reinet
- Grahamstown
- Queenstown

Since then, the province has been combining their intersectoral members meetings with the 3<sup>rd</sup> structure meetings until last financial year.

As from this financial year that is coming to an end on 31 March 2025 and moving forward, the EC provincial office has been directed to revert to the previous process which is according to the statute and with that the East London & Mdantsane were first in line.

The PSA values the opportunity and participation of as many members as possible to attend the intersectoral meetings across the province. The PSA is committed to making these meetings as accessible as possible for all members. The PSA will be making the final announcement of the next center to host the inter-sectoral members meeting after the approval by management. The next intersectoral members meeting after East London and Mdantsane will be held towards the end of this year.

Thank you for your ongoing participation and support. The PSA looks forward to seeing you at our upcoming meeting on 20 March 2025.
