Feedback: Gauteng DID: PMOG – Planned transfer of service and employees from DID to Department of Health

Consultation

The Office of the Premier and the Department of Infrastructure Development (DID) invited the PSA and other labour formations to a consultation process at Charlotte Maxeke Hospital to present the plan and progress of the transfer of services and employees from the DID to the Department of Health. The meeting did not achieve its purpose as the PSA informed the employer that it had jumped the gun and failed to use the lawful structure for consultation, which is the provincial chamber, known as the Coordinating Chamber for Provincial Gauteng Province (CCPGP). The PSA informed the employer that it must prepare correct documentation for consultation and meet the PSA in the CCPGP for discussion.

Coordinating Chamber for Provincial Gauteng Province (CCPGP) meeting

On 3 February 2025, a special CCPGP was convened to discuss the document presented by the employer. In the meeting, the PSA was clear that the document presented does not address the critical issues that affect members; it fails to identify workers who are affected; and it is not clear on what must be achieved after consultation. The employer was forced to go back and rework the document for presentation. The next special CCPGP meeting will be convened on 14 February 2025. Members will be updated on developments. Once the document for consultation is ready, the PSA will begin to consult members at all affected institutions.
