LGSETA wage negotiations: REQUEST FOR MANDATE

Members are aware that the PSA has been engaged in salary and conditions of service negotiations with LGSETA. The employer has now tabled what it considers to be its final offer, which serves as a counterproposal to the PSA's demands. Members' mandate is required to determine the way forward.

The employer has indicated its intention to finalise and sign the wage agreement **before the end of March 2025**. The PSA now seeks members' mandate on whether to **ACCEPT or REJECT** the employer's offer as a complete package.

If **accepted**, the offer will be **binding in full**. If **rejected**, all elements of the offer will be **declined**.
