PSCBC salary negotiations: **URGENT MANDATE REQUIRED: SUBMIT YOUR VOTE!**

PSA Informus, dated 21 January 2025, refers. Following negotiations, the employer on 20 January 2025 presented a final offer with notable improvements in respect of the cost-of-living adjustment, housing allowance, the individual-linked savings facility, medical-aid adjustments, danger allowance, special danger allowance, and service allowance for Police. In addition, the employer and organised labour have also agreed to resolve other demands through separate processes and a collective agreement, i.e., **Death Grant, Comprehensive Danger Insurance, Childcare and breastfeeding facilities, Bursary scheme for dependents, Recruitment Policy, Uniform Policy, and Incentive Policy Framework.**

YOUR MANDATE IS REQUIRED

PSA members must provide a mandate to **ACCEPT** or **REJECT** the offer as a package. If accepted, the multi-term agreement will be binding in its entirety; if rejected, all elements will be declined.
