PSA offers study grants

The PSA offers study grants to members and their children towards obtaining qualifications in Education as well as Natural Sciences and Medicine.

For **Education**-related studies, the PSA provides study grants to students studying towards such a qualification at a registered College or University in South Africa. Students can apply for the funding from the second year of study. The value of the study assistance is R5 000 per recipient. Grants are made, subject to available funding, based on students' performance and financial need.

The PSA has since 1994 been assisting students in **Natural Science** or **Medicine** by means of the Stiglingh Memorial Bursary as a legacy of late PSA member, Mr J H Stiglingh. Students can, from the second year of study, apply for this Bursary on an annual basis through the relevant University. Details and information with regards to the Bursary are provided by the PSA to all Universities in South Africa.

Who qualifies for assistance?

PSA members and/or public servants (who have been in the employ of the Public Service or a member of the PSA for at least twelve months on the closing date of the year in which a bursary is applied for), and their dependant children who follow undergraduate or post-graduate studies part-time or full-time in EDUCA-TION, NATURAL SCIENCES or MEDICINE, or who are involved in research on Natural Sciences or Medicine at a recognised South African University in South Africa or abroad can apply after successful completion of the first study-year course or research project.
