PSA's PHSDSBC campaign going strong!

The PSA's national campaign in the Public Health and Social Development Sector (PHSDSBC) continues with employees in the Sector increasingly realising the value of membership of the Union of Choice.

Shop stewards are encouraged to ensure that members are provided with updates on labour-related matters, and that their concerns are addressed without delay.

The campaign also offers PSA representatives to assist with growing the PSA's membership in the Sector by recruiting new members to the Union.

"Shop stewards are best positioned to deal with employees' issues as they are stationed in the workplaces and are thus also affected. It is important to remember that some issues faced by members can only be resolved by the PSA when the Union is in the majority position, which will increase its bargaining power", said PSA Assistant General Manager: Liaison, Tahir Maepa.

PSA Provincial Offices, with the support of shop stewards, have been hard at work since October 2016 to increase the PSA's PHS-DSBC standing. The campaign is rendering good results with more than 3 400 new members having been recruited to date. PSA Provincial Offices in the Free State, Mthatha, Pietermaritzburg, Port Elizabeth and Durban are the current front runners.

"The PSA encourages all shop stewards to continue in the final

stretch of the campaign with even more dedication and vigour in service of the members of the Union. Although the campaign ends in December 2016, excellent service

delivery to members and the vision to improve the Union's voting power in PHSDSBC will continue beyond that", said Tahir.
